PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In the spirit of the "Weimar Triangle", 24 young people from Germany, France, and Poland will come together to exchange ideas and immerse themselves in each other's cultures and languages. Participants from Weimar and its twin towns, Blois in France, and Zamość in Poland, will engage in meaningful discussions on topics such as "Europe, democracy, and diversity". Through intercultural learning and creative workshops, they will explore these themes while developing new friendships and shared European perspectives.

The program includes a variety of dynamic activities, from creative workshops to engaging excursions, including a boat tour and city tour. These experiences are designed to encourage intercultural understanding and collaboration, ensuring that learning is not only educational but also enjoyable and memorable.

Our goals

- I. Promotion of international exchange between young people from the partner cities.**
- II. Getting to know the world of other young people in Europe.**
- III. Promote the town twinning of Weimar, Blois, Zamość within the framework of the Weimar Triangle.**
- IV. Intercultural learning and application of non-formal and experiential educational methods.**
- V. Active participation of young people in the design of the project.**

Our main Topics

Europe: The young people discuss about Europe's role and influence in the world, highlighting its contributions and addressing global challenges.

Democracy: The committed young people strengthen their contact with the local government of their city and formulate youth policy ideas that they would like to implement.

Diversity: Highlight the importance of diversity by making it visible and appreciating different languages, origins, and ways of thinking.

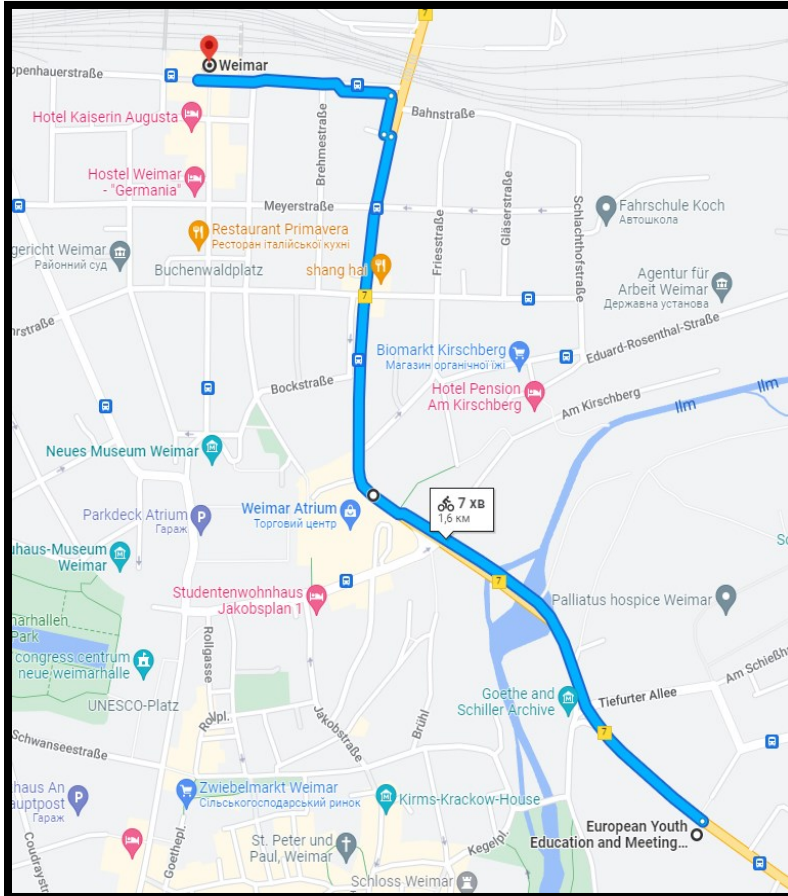

IN WEIMAR

After arrival at the main train station:

Option I



- 1) In front of the main entrance of the railway station take a bus no. 1 (direction: Ehringsdorf) to the bus stop “Friedensstraße / Atrium”;
- 2) Change (cross the road and change the direction) to bus no. 2 (direction: Bodelschwinghstraße) or bus no. 9 (direction: Süßenborn) and disembark after one stop at “Hellerweg / EJBW – European Youth Education and Meeting Centre”.

Single fare – 2,30 Euro

Single fare (4-ticket-set) - 8,30 Euro

1-day ticket – 6,20 Euro

Tickets are to be bought from a driver.

Option II

You can take bus no. 1 (direction: Ehringsdorf) from outside the railway station to the bus stop “Friedensstraße / Atrium” and follow the main road (Jenaer Straße) uphill for approx. 800 m and enter the area of EJBW at your right.
